

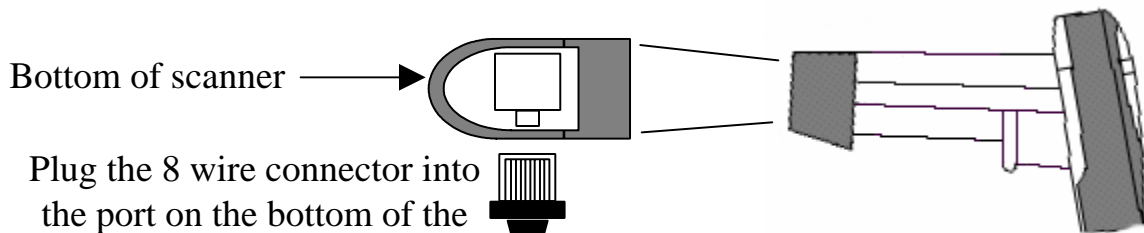
PSC Quick Scan 6000 Plus With Keyboard Wedge

This scanner is designed to connect to any ps/2 style keyboard and keyboard port. It can be connected to an AT style keyboard or keyboard port by means of an adapter. It can be used with the following terminals:

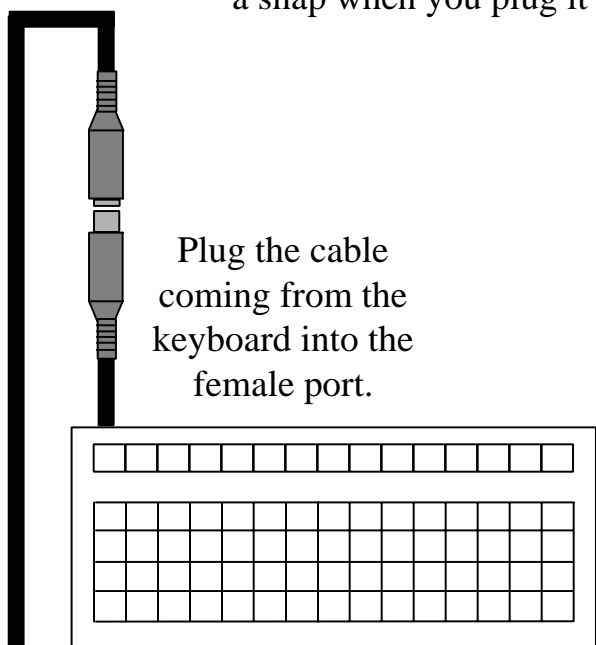
Serial Spot Line

Thin Client

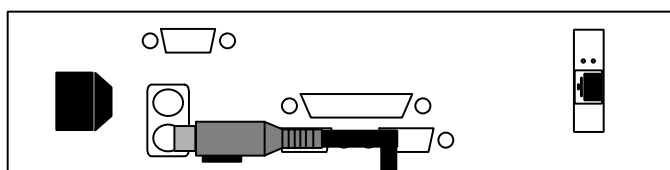


Plug the 8 wire connector into the port on the bottom of the scanner. Make sure you hear a snap when you plug it in.



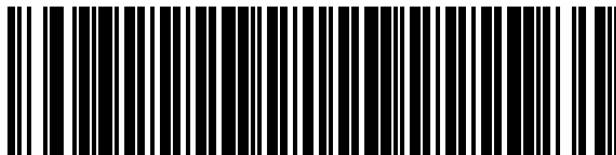
Plug the cable coming from the keyboard into the female port.

Plug the male cable into the keyboard port on the back of the terminal. The keyboard port is generally the port on the bottom or on the left.

PSC Quick Scan 6000 Plus With Keyboard Wedge

This section will set the scanner to append two carriage returns to the output of the scanner. This means that when you scan an item in point of sale it will place the cursor on the next line. When the scanner is set to defaults it is set to append only one carriage return. This means that when an item is scanned in point of sale the cursor will stop on the quantity field. If you want the cursor to stop on the quantity field do not scan this section. If you do not want to stop on the quantity field or you do not know, continue scanning this section.
