

TI Microlaser and Adding a FX Emulator Card

Adding an FX Emulator Card

NOTE: If the FX Emulator Card already exists in you printer, proceed to step (4).

1. Turn off power to printer.
2. Insert the FX Emulator Card into the left side down close to the bottom of the printer. There are two slots that may be used, either slot will do.
3. After inserting the Emulator Card, turn on the power.
4. After the printer goes through it's checking and initializing phase:

On the keypad on the front of the printer hit the	(Offline key)
On the keypad on the front of the printer - Hit the	(Printer Setup key)
You will see in the liquid display	(Set p7I" Pers Pft)
On the keypad on the front of the printer hit the	(Select key)
You will see in the liquid display	(Pers Prt=I)
On the keypad on the front of the printer hit the	(Select key)
You will see in the liquid display	(PPI:Emulator)
On the keypad on the front of the printer hit the	(Select key)
You will see in the liquid display	(Emulator=???)
On the keypad on the front of the printer Hit the (Next key) until you see	(Emulator=EPSON)

Once you see the (Emulator=EPSON) in the liquid display, hit the (Select key), and then hit the (Online key to store it in memory.
