

SLAVED PRINTER IN BASIC

There are three areas when using Basic that you will need to set up for slaving a printer off of a Terminal.

Enter into your **Main Menu>Misc. Menu>Point of Sale Forms and Printer Setup>**

1. Select the Workstation that you are wanting to slave the printer off of.
2. Change the "Cash Slip Printer" line to read "**Z**" printer in the printer id slot.

Now, from the Main menu go to **>Utility Menu>Configure Printer Types>**

1. Go to the workstation number that you want to slave under "**Dedicated Printer**".
2. Then enter in the proper type of "slaved" printer that you are going to use (In my example that would be a "Star" (cash slip printer)

NOTE: As you will notice, printers "A-Z" are what you currently have setup as your serial Printers. In other words, everyone is printing to them now.

The final stage in your process is the setup of your Printer in the new "sysut" menu.

From the prompt type, # **sysut**

Next, Select **Printers>Software Printer Maint>Insert..** "Add a new printer"

Your final screen should resemble this example below:
