

BADTRK Vs. FSCK

If you receive an error referring to Bad Block or unrecoverable read or write error, then you should run a **badtrk** on the Hard Drive "First"

Then run the **fsck** on the Hard Drives

If you receive an **inode, hdfs**, or anything other than the above listed, this will require you to run a fsck on the Drives.

NOTE: A "Panic" typically requires a fsck and reorganization of Datasets!
