

## Making a Dos Boot Disk that will Support IDE CD ROMs

Insert a disk in the 'A' drive. Make sure the disk is not write protected. From the DOS prompt type:

**format a:**

**C:\**

**sys a:**

**copy c:\windows\command\fdisk.exe a:\**

**copy c:\windows\command\format.com a:\**

**copy c:\windows\command\sys.com a:\**

**copy c:\windows\command\mscdex.exe a:\**

**copy c:\windows\command\atapicd.sys a:\**

**copy con a:\config.sys**

**device=atapicd.sys /d:cdrom001**

**(ctrl +Z) (enter)**

**copy con a:\autoexec.bat**

**mscdex.exe /d:cdrom001**

**(ctrl+Z) (enter)**
