

Rootbackup Tape Testing

To test the reading capability of your Rootbackup tape, you can follow the example (1) script command.

General command line syntax for listing the files on a backup:

(1) Example: List the files on tape:

```
# cpio -icvtB -I/dev/rStp0 (Primary) (For secondary substitute rStp0 with rStp1)
```

(2) Example: List the files on a tape that has corrupted file headers:

```
# cpio -icvtkB -I/dev/rct0
```

Testing Procedures for Root & Boot Floppys

Start your CPU with the Boot Floppy in your floppy drive (You should now boot off your Boot Floppy)

If your boot floppy is good...

You will next be prompted to insert your Root Floppy, do so now and hit the enter key.

When completed properly, you should be to a “#” prompt.

From that prompt type the following command after you have removed your floppies and written the Words “tested by so/n/so this date”

```
# reboot
```

Then bring your system up and go to work!
