Description:

OpenServer 5.0.6 (with Release Supplement 5.0.6a installed) double panics with trap E during a user login. A message similar to:

PANIC: License data corruption - LB(978) already set

is displayed.

Solution:

This problem is caused by license corruption, which can occasionally occur. The problem has been reported to Caldera Engineering.

In order to work around the problem, please take the following steps:

1. Run "scoadmin license" as the root user
2. Remove all of the user licenses
3. Re-add the user licenses
4. Reboot the system

If the system panics while you are attempting the work around, please try restarting the machine with a bootstring of "defbootstr ksl.disable"; booting into maintenance (single-user) mode and then running "scoadmin license".
