

Printers/Printer Configuration for Message Manager

NOTE: YOU HAVE TO HAVE SUPERUSER ACCESS TO SET UP THESE PRINTERS!

From the prompt type # **cd /abcsconfigs** then hit the enter key
(Above the prompt you should now have /abcsconfigs)

From the prompt type # **lf** then hit the enter key
(You should now have a list of all the abcsconfigs directory files displayed)

The file that you are interested in editing is “**setmmvars**”

From the prompt type # **n! setmmvars** then hit the enter key
(You are now ready to edit this file)

The file line that you need to edit is **MMPRINTERS=**

For a Single Printer Setup, edit the line as follows....

MMPRINTERS="laser5a" (this is ONLY an example)

(When you have finished editing your line, Hit the F2 Key, and X to save the file)

For a Multiple Printer Setup, edit the line as follows...

MMPRINTERS="laser5a printer_a printer_b" (this is ONLY an example)

(When you have finished editing your line, hit the F2 Key, and X to save the file)

NOTE:

To make sure that your printers are displaying/working properly. Edit the export line (located just below the MMPRINTER line) to look something like the following.

export MPRINTERS

Generally the export line will have other export items also; a good example is...

```
Export MPRINTERS MMFAXBOARD MMSWAPKO MMWBEEPS MMPRINTTXT  
MMEXPORT MMIMPORT MMWBEEPS
```

MAKE SURE TO PRESS THE F-2 KEY AND "X" KEY TO SAVE EDITING FILES

Make sure that you then log out of the terminal that you are wanting to refresh with your Current printer setup. Log back in, and you should see your new printer/printers.
