

## Making a bootable Linux 7.1 diskette In Windows

- 1.) Insert the Red Hat Linux 7.1 CD 1 into the CD-ROM drive
- 2.) In Windows, click **Start**
- 3.) Click **Run** from the pop-up menu.
- 4.) Click **Browse**
- 5.) Beside *look in* choose your CD-ROM drive from the drop down list.
- 6.) Double-click **dosutils**
- 7.) Double-click **rawrite**
- 8.) Click **OK**
- 9.) A window will open, at *Enter disk image source file name:* type **d:\images\boot.img [Enter]** where d: is the drive letter of your CD-ROM.
- 10.) It will now prompt *Enter target diskette drive:* type **a [Enter]**
- 11.) Press **[Enter]** again.
- 12.) When it is done the window will either close itself or the title bar will say FINISHED. You may close the window if it doesn't close itself.
