

Using Floppy Disks in Linux

1. Copying file to floppy disk in linux.

a. Type `#mount /dev/fd0`

b. Then from the directory with the file you want to copy type `#cp "filename" /mnt/floppy` example: `#cp test /mnt/floppy`

c. When done with the floppy drive type `#umount /dev/fd0`

2. Copying file from floppy disk in linux

a. Type `#mount /dev/fd0`

b. Type `#cd /mnt/floppy`

c. Then type `#cp "filename" /"target directory"` example:
`#cp test /root`
